

## 2023-2024 Supply List – FIFTH GRADE

Parents often wonder about what kinds of supplies they should buy for the school year. What follows is a suggested supply list that can be used as a **guide** for September school shopping. **Make sure that your child's name and grade are permanently marked on all supplies.** 

**Backpacks K-5:** Smaller backpacks are more advantageous for young students. A larger backpack encourages students to carry too much weight. Generally students K-2 only need room for a planner and folder. Grades 3-5 only need room for a few smaller books. We discourage the use of wheeled backpacks.

<u>Snacks K-5:</u> Students are given a small amount of time for a snack each day. We plan to continue this practice next year with the following parameters: Snacks must be small, easily opened, and nutritious (fruit, vegetables, crackers, pretzels, etc.). Soda is NOT permitted. Bagged juices are discouraged. No microwave facilities are available.

<u>Devices:</u> The South Brunswick Schools will continue its 1:1 use of personal device program when we return in September. Each student in grades 2 through 12 is to bring a district issued device or personal device to school for use each day and the charger.

If needed, you may borrow a district issued Chromebook by contacting the school. There is a \$35 insurance fee to cover the costs of accidental damage. Students may also bring their personal device each day.

- 3-Pack of Large Glue Sticks (labeled w/ initials in permanent marker). Please only bring 1 in at a time.
- 2 Large Erasers
- Small Personal Pencil Sharpener (labeled w/ initials in permanent marker.)
- #2 Pencils (marked with initials or name) \*no mechanical pencils
- 1 3 pack of 3 x 3 Post-it Notes (labeled w/ initials in permanent marker). Please only bring 1 in at a time.
- 1 Zippered Pencil Bag
- Spiral Notebook of Each (Wide Ruled and All Labeled with name): Yellow (labeled as Math); Green (labeled as Science); any color (labeled as Spelling)
- Wide Ruled Marble Composition book (labeled as Spanish). Student's name should be labeled on the books.
- 7 Two-Pocket Folders of each (All Labeled with Name):
  Blue (labeled as S.S.); Yellow (labeled as Math);
  Green (labeled as Science); Red (labeled as Reading);
  Your choice (labeled as Spanish); Your choice
  (labeled as Writing); Your choice (labeled as
  Homework)

- Hard Marble Composition Notebook (labeled with your name), color of choice, labeled as Writing, (approx. 200 pages) decorated and protected (preferred).
- 1 Pair of small scissors
- 1 Box colored pencils 12 count
- Independent Reading Book: One you are about to begin or that you are currently reading, but haven't finished
- 2 Highlighters (any two colors), labeled with name
- Sharpie (black) Fine Tip (labeled with initials in permanent marker)
- Red 3-Subject Spiral Notebook, Wide Ruled (labeled with name), Labeled as Reading
- Set of headphones/earbuds (for computer use Please place in a Ziploc bag labeled with your child's name in permanent marker.
- Dry Erase Markers-Fine Tip (dark colors prefered).Bring a small cloth to use as an eraser.
- Independent Reading Book-one you are about to begin or one that you are currently reading, but have not finished.

\*Math Supplies: (Accelerated Math) will be determined once math begins\*
